The Trinity Explained:

- I. God Works in Harmony. He works through all three persons.
- II. The Father stands atop the work and has authority
 - A. Philippians 2:9-11
- III. The Son is committed to doing the will of the Father, in submission to His authority
 - A. John 8:28-69
 - B. John 6:38
 - C. 1 Corinthians 15:25-28
- IV. The Spirit is subject to Christ and enjoys shining the spotlight upon Him.
 - A. John 16:12-14

The Trinity Applied :: 1 Corinthians 11:2-3 Husband and wives are 2 in 1 as God is 3 in 1.

- · There is equality in marriage.
- The husband and wife have different functions, just like then members of the Trinity.
 - Different functions do no denote importance or inequality.

The wife is referred to as a "helper."

- The Father as Helper :: Psalm 30:10, Psalm 54:4
- The Spirit as Helper :: John 14:26, 15:26

There were gender roles before the Fall into sin.

He created Adam first, and then he created Eve for Adam.
Adam named Eve.
Adam was the one held responsible for the Fall into sin.
Their punishments matched their roles.
