





Aword from our Interim Pastor

Have you considered the importance of the coming weeks to the life of the church? We know the holidays are coming and we anticipate the special music and services during December. Most of our thinking is about what we will experience personally. I want to challenge you to think about the unchurched you know during these days we look forward to so much. Along with the Easter season in the spring, this is the most likely time the unchurched might attend a worship event and be open to the Gospel. So at the outset of this article, I urge you to begin praying now and planting seeds with the unchurched about joining you for some of the special services of the coming season.

How are we doing with "Faith Rising?" We are so pleased to know that gifts have surpassed 20 % of our goal during the month of October. Our goal is not just a monetary amount, but rather, that every member would have the joy of making some gift toward the debt reduction so that we might all rejoice in fresh ministry opportunities which will be provided by debt elimination. This old phrase still applies, "Not equal gifts, but equal sacrifice." You can feel free to use a regular envelope for your gift and indicate the amount on the section which has been labeled "Secure the Vision." Those words were already printed on the envelopes and will make sure the gift goes toward debt reduction. You can make a one-time gift or a series of them if that is better for you. Just pray and follow what the Lord places on your heart. He will never desire to take from you what you need and will do with it more than you ever could!

Thank you church for the cards, thoughtful expressions, and gifts during the Minister Appreciation Month just passed. Judy and I are so grateful for each of you. Also, let me commend Paul, Janet, and Blake for their service to this church. It is a joy to work with them and to see how God is blessing us through their unselfish commitment.

Pray for the work of our Pastor Search Committee. I also urge you to share a special prayer for our beloved former Pastor, Bro. Mark Stokes, and his family as he is very seriously ill.
